Dear Commissioner Braidwood,

As discussed following my appearance before the Commission on May 12, 2008, I would like to reiterate several points from my submission, and add one recommendation regarding the use of conducted energy weapons that I hope you will consider when writing your report at the conclusion of this inquiry.

There are certain conditions that I believe should be met as quickly as possible for the continued use of conducted energy weapons in Canada. They are:

- I. Repositioning on the use of force spectrum
- II. National standards for use and training
- III. Better training
- IV. Better reporting
- V. More independent research into the science and safety of conducted energy weapons

I would add that if no measures are taken to address these conditions, I would recommend a temporary moratorium on the use of such devices.

Many thanks again for the invitation to present to the Commission. I look forward to reading your final report and recommendations on this matter.
